### **SPECIAL EDUCATION POLICY**

A well-defined special education policy has been framed and articulated as per the need of the hour. A trained full-time counsellor provides her support to students, teachers and parents in all working days. Irrespective of that, all the teachers were trained to handle the children, those who needs special care. A mentoring system has been developed with the help of senior teachers to identify learning gaps among the children. We respect the rights of the children so that the campus evolved as child friendly and a system of joyful learning persists in all sense. Our special education policy comprises three major areas;

1. Identification of the problem.
2. Intervention
3. Remediation

Remedial Teaching sessions were organised by the teachers after class hours and holidays with the support of parents and help the children to compensate their learning gaps.

### **DEBATE /DISCUSSIONS /SEMINARS**

School focuses on activities which are useful for the children to explore their innate talents and capabilities. Our Debate club organized various sessions based on the relevant issues and it helped the children to learn, unlearn and re-learn.

### **EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING**

We do not believe in the outdated system of rote learning and the traditional chalk and talk method, instead of that the focus is shifted to experiential learning strategies as suggested by Central Board of Secondary Education. Our teachers always trying to convert the class rooms as learning labs and there the teachers acted as facilitators. The pragmatic school of thought of ‘learning by doing is’ systematically applied in primary level with the support of specifically designed games and activities.

**DEPARTMENT WISE REPORTS**

**DEPT. OF TAMIL**

Dept. of Tamil has implemented Qrius Tamil a unique way of teaching Tamil through lojg story method – upto III standard. This will develop all the basic skills of LSRW of the students. The doubts and queries of the parents were cleared by conducting a number of meetings and discussions. Parents are very satisfied in this.

On behalf of the Tamil Literary Club a Debate has been conducted. A Kavi Arankan has been conducted in which a large number of students participated. A Language Exhibition was also conducted on 7th December 2019. Students displayed books, equipment, materials etc. depicting ancient Tamil Culture that attracted all the visitors.

The Tamil festival Pongal was also celebrated with lot of sprit and enthusiasm. Traditional dances and games are performed. Sugarcanes are distributed to students.

**DEPT. OF MALAYALAM**

From June to December 2019, Malayalam dept. had conducted many activities for the improvement of the students. We provided regular practices like Diary writing, Newspapers & books reading and speaking on various topics. Apart from these, we had provided smart class facilities also for showing videos related with lessons, moral stories for lower classes etc. Many competitions like Recitation, Versification, Elocution, and Essay Writing were also conducted for inculcating interest and encouragement among the students and also helping them to overcome stage fear and impart leadership qualities, knowledge etc. Our students were getting motivated by providing chances for

#### **DEPT. OF HINDI**

##### **Scholastic:**

Remedial classes are conducted for slow learners as to improve their academic performance.

Aural + Oral tests are conducted to check the skills related to language proficiency.

##### **Co-Scholastic:**

Essay, Elocution, Versification competitions were conducted to improve the proficiency of the language.

Recitation for class I to XII was conducted and students were taught how to recite the poem with aesthetic sense.

Role plays and skits were conducted to improve the understanding ability of the students.

#### **DEPT. OF FRENCH**

Efforts have been made to improve the basic skills of the students in French. Essay competition was conducted as usual. During the language exhibition, French students also participated. They displayed charts, pictures, models and food items depicting the French culture and heritage. Continuous efforts are being made to make the students' scores marks in board examinations.

#### **DEPT. OF ENGLISH**

The Department of English has been taking constant effort to enhance the four basic skills of the students. Through 'ripples' programme the students' communication skill is being strengthened. A reading test is being conducted to improve the skill. Competitions on Essay writing, Elocution, Versification, Recitation and Spell-bee are conducted every year. International Spell-bee competition and various other competitive exams organized by different organizations are also held. To bring out the hidden talents of the Kids we have conducted various competition such as Rhymes recitation, Clay modeling, Bhagavath Gita chanting, Thirukkural recitation, Colouring and Drawing, Fancy Dress competition, Tamil and English Elocution and Story Telling.

ANUGRAHA the Grand Parent's Day was celebrated on 30<sup>th</sup> August 2019. Sports Day was conducted in the month of October. Prize distribution ceremony was conducted on 14<sup>th</sup> November. Open House sessions were conducted periodically. Graduation Day for UKG students is going to be celebrated in the month of March. Different Color Days were observed and activities also were held by Kinder Garten wings. We conduct KG assembly on every Thursday. We organize 'Field Trip' for kids every year. Bridging Programme for Pre KG parents were conducted in the month of April. Guidance and Counselling was given to the students as well as parents periodically.
